West Woods Christian Academy is a private Christian School, founded in 1975, serving students from pre-school through the twelfth grade. Nine week Quarters are the pattern for the school year. Criteria for enrollment fall in two areas: grade readiness and religious conviction. Entrance and placement exams are given to students enrolling, and parent(s) need to have an Evangelical Christian worldview. W.W.C.A. is a member of the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI), and meets standards for approval by the Connecticut State Board of Education.

School Calendar: Aligned closely with Hamden Public Schools in Hamden, CT

School Day: Six class periods, study hall, and Devotions/Prayer/Chapel. Classes are 47 minutes.

Semester system: One credit per year is awarded for each five day per week class.
